









Walk around the house and name an object. Encourage your child to think of a word that rhymes with the word you said. Repeat with other objects.






Have children write a row of uppercase A and lowercase a. Then have them write a row of uppercase B and lowercase b.



Ask your child to show you how to write uppercase A and B, and lowercase a and b.


























Have children look at the pictures and repeat the words after you. Then have them talk about the forms of transportation they use.

Name each vehicle and have your child point to the corresponding picture.





Have your child describe the activity in his or her drawing. Name some other actions and include them in the song as you sing with your child.












Have children look at the pictures in the first row and circle the animals that can crawl. Next have them look at the pictures in the second row and circle the animals that can hop.










Point to an item and name it. Have children repeat after you. Then say the word and clap at each syllable. Have children clap with you. Repeat with other objects in the scene.






































Have children color the spots on the ladybug, count to 11, and trace the number. Next have them color the spots on the butterfly, count to 12, and trace the number.




